CERTIFICATION

The ADSM Certification Committee recognizes individuals with expertise in dental sleep medicine for the management of sleep related breathing disorders through examination. As desire on part of dentists and physicians to utilize oral appliances as a viable means to treat SBD increases, the need to identify practitioners who possess the education, knowledge and background in this specialty becomes critical to ensure proper treatment. The ADSM credential examination identifies individuals that possess appropriate proficiency in the field of dental sleep medicine, including sleep medicine, oral appliance therapy and related surgical procedures.

REIMBURSEMENT

The Reimbursement Committee represents members through relationships with nationwide payers and policy makers of dental sleep treatment services. The committee provides current information regarding changes in insurance reimbursement issues nationwide, including coding, reimbursement procedures, sample letters, and other issues relevant to ADSM members.
